- Blessed is the man who does not
- (1) walk in the counsel of the wicked or
- (2) stand in the way of sinners or
- (3) sit in the seat of \*mockers. (Psalms 1:1-2 詩篇第一篇 vv. 1-2)
- → ★Stay away from all evils and sins.

- \*mockers: to spoil something or stop it from happening

### **OO** The law of the LORD:

- Micah 6:8 <sup>8</sup> He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you?
- (1) To act justly and
- (2) to **love mercy** and
- (3) to walk humbly with your God.

1. The name "Abba Father" is one of the most significant names of God in understanding how He relates to people.

 Abba means "Father" – Abba is the most intimate form of God's name, showing us His character as our loving daddy.

• He is

- (1) the One who can be fully trusted,
- (2) the One we can lean on,
- (3) the One who cares about all that concerns us.

- Just as a godly father's presence in our daily lives is one of
- (1) protection,
- (2) security, and
- (3) unconditional love,
- the constant presence of our heavenly Father is what gives us the strength and covering we need for this life's journey.

#### He gives us the privilege of being called his own sons and daughters. → son-ship, inheritance

- He provides the way for us to call out to Him and the assurance, beyond a doubt, that He hears and will answer.
  → prayers
- In our most difficult to painful times in life, we can crawl up into the lap of our heavenly Father, and know that He is for us, and His arms will hold us secure. → provides help, support, strengthen, equip, comfort

2. Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father."

#### • Galatians 4:6

- Abba signifies the close, intimate relationship of a father and his child, as well as the childlike trust that a young child puts in his "daddy."
- we are assured of God's care for His children.

## Approach Him with boldness and confidence; and in full assurance of faith.

- we can
- (1) approach Him with "boldness" (<u>Hebrews 10:19</u> <sup>19</sup> Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we
- (2) have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus,) and
- (3) in "full assurance of faith" (Hebrews 10:22<sup>22</sup> let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having <u>our hearts</u> sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having <u>our bodies</u> washed with pure water.).

#### Indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

- The Holy Spirit "testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.
- Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ" (Romans 8:16–17<sup>16</sup> The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. <sup>17</sup> Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.).

#### Because of becoming a child of God, we have a *new* relationship with God and a *new* standing before Him.

 Instead of running from God and trying to hide our sin like Adam and Eve did, we run to Him, \*\*calling, "Abba, Father!" and finding forgiveness in Christ. What does that mean by being an adopted child of God?

- Being an adopted child of God is
- (1) the source of our hope,
- (2) the security of our future, and
- (3) the motivation to "live a life worthy of the calling you have received"
- (Ephesians 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.).

#### **Inheritance kept in heaven**

- Being children of the King of Kings and Lord of Lords calls us to a higher standard, a different way of life, and, in the future, "an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade" (<u>1 Peter 1:4</u>
  <sup>4</sup> and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you,).
- Acts 26:17-18 <sup>17</sup>
- (1) | will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles.
- (2) I am sending you to them <sup>18</sup> to open their eyes and
- (3) turn them from darkness to light, and
- (4) from the power of Satan to God, so that
- (5) they may **receive forgiveness of sins** and
- (6) a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.'

#### **American Standard Version**

- <sup>17</sup> delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom I send thee, <sup>18</sup> to open their eyes, that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive
- (5) remission (the fact of being forgiven for breaking religious laws or rules) of sins and
- (6) an <u>inheritance</u> among them that are <u>sanctified by faith</u> in me.

- When Jesus taught His disciples to pray, He began with the words Our Father.
- There is much truth in those two words alone.
- (1) The holy and righteous God, who
- (2) created and sustains all things, who
- (3) is all-powerful,
- (4) all-knowing, and
- (5) ever-present,
- not only allows us but encourages us to call Him "Father."

#### Cry of "Abba, Father!"

- (1) What a **privilege** is ours.
- (2) What amazing grace that God would love us so, that
- (3) Jesus would sacrifice Himself for us, and that
- (4) the Holy Spirit would indwell us and prompt our intimate cry of "Abba, Father!" → enlighten and empower us

# • Ephesians 2:14 <sup>14</sup> For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility,

- Colossians 2:13-14 <sup>13</sup> When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God
- (1) made you alive with Christ.
- (2) He forgave us all our sins, <sup>14</sup> having
- (3) canceled the charge of our legal *indebtedness*, which stood against us and condemned us;
- (4) He has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.

- **3. The range of meanings of the name Abba Father** includes **those of authority and discipline**, but also **those of compassion**, care, protection, and provision.
- Hebrews 12:7 <sup>7</sup> Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as his children. For what children are not disciplined by their father? → Olympic champion: highly disciplined physically along with mental stability and maturity

#### **Leadership Inside – Then Outside**

- Numbers 32:13 <sup>13</sup> The LORD's anger burned against Israel and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until the whole generation of those who had done evil in his sight was gone.
- •
- The first person you lead is you and you ★ cannot lead effectively without Self-discipline.
- If only the Israelites had remembered this lesson! For forty years the Israelites wondered around in the desert.
- Why didn't they get to the Promised Land more quickly? Not because it lay so far away – *they could have made the trip in two weeks*.
- The real reason boils down to **\* preparation**. <u>The people simply</u> <u>weren't ready for God's blessing</u> until forty years after they began their trip.
- *Discipline*: the ability to control, even in difficult situations

- How about you? How is your self-discipline? Plato said, "<u>The first and</u> best victory is to conquer self."
- If you want to be \*\*leader with <u>self-discipline</u>, follow these <u>action</u> <u>points</u>:
- Develop and follow your priorities.
- Make a **disciplined lifestyle** your goal.
- Challenge your excuses.
- Remove rewards until you finish the job.
- Stay focused on results.

- Matthew 28:18-20<sup>18</sup> Then Jesus came to them and said,
- (1) "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Therefore
- (2) go and make disciples of all nations,
- (2a) baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and
- (2b) teaching them to obey *everything* I have commanded you.
- (3) And *surely* I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

 2 Thessalonians 3 <sup>3</sup> But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

 Psalm 33:9 <sup>9</sup> For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood *firm*.

• Hebrews 13:8 <sup>8</sup> Jesus Christ is *the same yesterday and today and forever*.

## Jehovah-jireh: In the mount of Jehovah it shall be provided

- Genesis 22:14
- NIV So Abraham called that place The LORD Will Provide. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."
- ASV And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of Jehovah it shall be provided.

#### Yahweh Nissi means "The Lord Is My Banner"

- Yahweh Nissi means "The Lord Is My Banner" This is the name of God that proclaims His
- (1) protection,
- (2) leadership, and
- (3) deliverance for His people.
- Just as God brought divine protection for the Israelites against their enemy, the Amalekites, He offers us protection and deliverance today from the enemies we may face in this life.

- Exodus 17:15
- NIV Moses built an altar and called it The LORD is my Banner.
- <u>ASV</u> And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovah-nissi;

#### Jehovah Rapha means "Healer, the Lord who heals you"

- Jehovah Rapha means "Healer, the Lord who heals you" This name brings so much comfort and hope to many of us who have prayed for
- healing and deliverance from
- (1) disease, illness,
- (2) brokenness, or
- (3) painful circumstances.
- It reminds us that God knows we're in need of help, He understands we're in need of healing, and He promises to redeem every broken place in our lives. <u>He never leaves us on</u> our own to fend for ourselves.

- Exodus 15:26
- NIV He said,
- (1) "If you *listen* carefully to the LORD your God and *do* what is right *in his eyes*,
- (2) if you pay attention to his commands and keep *all* his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for *I am the LORD*, who heals you."
Immediately after the Lord "healed" the waters of Marah, He identified Himself to them as *Jehovah-Rapha*: "I am the Lord, who heals you" (Exodus 15:26). He doesn't just heal water; He heals people. The healing of the waters was a demonstration of God's power to overcome any impurity, contamination, or corruption. This power was going to work on behalf of the Israelites, God's chosen people, as the Lord brought them to the Promised Land. (https://www.gotquestions.org/Jehovah-Rapha.html)





- Exodus 34:6 <sup>6</sup> And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness,

- <sup>6</sup> And Jehovah passed by before him, and proclaimed, Jehovah, Jehovah,
- (1) a God merciful and gracious,
- (2) slow to anger, and
- (3) abundant in lovingkindness and truth;

- Psalm 121:7-8 <sup>7</sup> The LORD will keep you from all harm he will watch over your life;

- → *scope* and *duration* of His protection and of His care (all; over your life; *both now and forevermore*)

## Yahweh Shalom means "The Lord Is Peace"

- Yahweh Shalom means "The Lord Is Peace" God is the only One able to give us the peace that passes all of our own understanding.
  ↔ doubts, fears, uncertainties, worries (Things don't always (80%~90%) work out as you think. "人生不如意事十有八九")
- Gideon knew this well from a time that he and his people were surrounded by a fierce enemy. There was nothing about that time that seemed "peaceful."
- And yet, God showed up strong on their behalf; He was faithful and brought deliverance straight through fear-filled days.

- Judges 6:24
- NIV So Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it The LORD Is Peace. To this day it stands in Ophrah of the Abiezrites (a city of Manasseh, 6 miles (10 km) southwest of Shechem, the residence of Gideon).
- NOG So Gideon built an altar there to Yahweh. He called it Yahweh Shalom. To this day it is still in Ophrah, which belongs to Abiezer's family.

4. The right to be a child of God and call Him "Abba Father" is something that only born-again Christians have (John 1:12–13).

- Many claim that all people are "children of God," but the Bible reveals quite a different truth.
- We are
- (1) all His creations and
- (2) under His authority and lordship, and
- (3) all will be judged by Him, but
- (4) the right to be a child of God and call Him "Abba Father" is something that only born-again Christians have (John 1:12–13).

## John 1:12–13

- <sup>12</sup> Yet
- (1) to all who did receive him,
- (2) to those who believed in his name (believe: think that something is true, correct, or real), → trust and obey (thought + realization)
- He gave the right to become children of God—<sup>13</sup> children
- (1) born not of natural descent,
- (2) nor of human decision or a husband's will, but
- (3) born of God.
