TESTIMONY - MICHAEL CHENG

Hello everyone, I am Michael. I am delighted to have the opportunity to share my testimony with you today. I joined the 4C Church about a year and a half ago, which was when I began to learn about this faith and come to know God. Prior to that, I knew nothing about Christianity. I grew up in a family that practices Taoism, and I never thought I would come into contact with another faith. Today, I would like to share my testimony by sharing a few stories about myself.

The first story is about my family. My dad passed away from cancer before I went to college, and I have two older sisters who are nine and eleven years older than me. After my dad passed away, my eldest sister also passed away from cancer a few years later while I was studying abroad, so I experienced the loss of family members at a young age. As a child growing up in a family that practices Taoism, during the times when my dad and sister were ill, my family adhered to traditional beliefs and felt that we had to do something before they would get better. So, we were asked to do many things like being vegetarian, then later on, not allowed to eat beef, wearing Buddhist beads, copying scriptures, and going to the temple to pray, etc. I found it strange. Isn't God supposed to be all about unconditional love? Isn't it supposed to be about giving without any conditions? Why does it feel like we are negotiating, and I have to do a certain amount of things before they will come and help us? Moreover, there seem to be different levels of things that we have to do. It just didn't seem reasonable to me. Later, a relative told us that they had shared the condition of our family members' illnesses with their church, and the entire church community was praying for us. That was my first impression of Christianity. It was also the first time I had a question in my mind. Why? Why would people pray for strangers? Are they really trying to help us? We don't even know who they are.

The second story is about my experience joining the small group. My first impression of the group was that everyone was so open and willing to share their difficulties and inner thoughts. Even for me, a first-time attendee, everyone presented their most authentic selves openly and honestly. I found it surprising. To me, these struggles and difficulties are very personal and hard to talk about, and I would never be able to share them so openly with someone I just met. I thought we should present our best selves to strangers, but everyone seemed to share with me as if we'd known each other for a long time. This was my second impression of Christianity and the second question that arose in my mind. Why? Why are you telling me? Are you sure I won't gossip about what you shared with me today? Why do you trust me so much?

However, as I got to know God and Christianity, I received answers. I came to understand that the true God loves us unconditionally, without any conditions or expectations, even to the point of suffering and carrying the burden of our sins. In the past, I used to follow my family to worship different idols and even had to give offerings and gifts regularly, but now I know that only the true God will love us unconditionally without expecting anything in return.

In the past, I used to think that when something bothered me, as a man, I should keep it to myself and not show it to others. Sharing it with others would seem like a sign of weakness and revealing my vulnerability was something to be ashamed of. However, now I feel blessed to have a small group to share and pray with. Because I was the only boy in my family, I didn't have anyone to share my thoughts with or communicate with growing up. I used to think I was super strong and arrogant, thinking that I could handle and solve everything on my own. I always thought that if I couldn't solve something, it was simply because I wasn't trying hard enough. Now I know that not all problems have answers and that not everything can be solved by oneself. I also learned that I am not alone and that many people may face similar issues. Sharing with the small group is not shameful and it is okay to pray together.

Those who are in the same small group with me may know that I have encountered many difficulties in my journey of faith, such as strong opposition from my family, to the point where they did inappropriate things and did not respect life. I hope that everyone can continue to pray for me and my family, hoping that they can also experience what I have experienced, knowing that they cannot control everything, knowing how to communicate properly, praying to God, and sharing with others is such a warm thing. Moreover, this God loves us unconditionally, and does not come to negotiate with us based on conditions or benefits. That is my testimony for today. Thank you !

Before I believe in Jesus

During my 20 years of life, there was a significant period of time when I had no contact with this faith, and I did not know this God. Although I experienced many things during that time, both good and bad, I considered myself very happy, and I attributed this happiness to my family who loved me. However, as I grew older and approached the end of my university years, I began to think about a question: what kind of life do I want to live? Without you, I might have never known this God for my whole life. I am truly grateful that Jesus guided me to know Him and helped me.

How my life has changed after believing in Jesus

God is like a teacher to me; he loves me so much, He guides and teaches me with care. There were many things and hurdles I couldn't overcome before I knew God, but He knows everything. Before I knew God, I thought I had the ability to distinguish right from wrong. If I thought I was right, then I was really right, and if I thought someone else was wrong, then they really were wrong. So when others made mistakes, I would blame them, and when I was not wrong, I would not apologize. But God told me it was not supposed to be like that. Matthew 6:15 says, "But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins." It turns out that we are all sinners, and we all make mistakes. At this point in my life, I am still learning, and I think this is an important lesson in my life. I am willing to spend more time learning and understanding this God. That is why I am standing here today.
