In October 2022, I had a conversation with Mrs. Kao to talk about my plans for the future. On that day, I told her that I had initially wanted to study psychology in graduate school, but I ended up working in clinical settings for 3 years. In my work, I encountered children with ADHD and autism, along with their parents, as well as people with insomnia and those suffering from fibromyalgia. Although my boss was a professional psychologist and our research involved intervention therapies, offering psychological treatments during the research process but I couldn't help but see the limitations of psychological therapy when I looked at those individuals. I knew that the best solution lies in Jesus, and I have a A plan and the answer in my hand, but all I could offer them was a plan B. I felt so helpless when I am not even able to pray for them.

I have always been a person without any sense of direction for the future. For three years after graduating, I even felt that this world was meaningless. It was only when I started serving at the student small group that I witnessed a small group member who had lost hope in life finding light through prayers and companionship. Now, she is involved in various ministries at the church and have been trying to bring friends to the church as well.





Additionally, my perspective changed when my mother was diagnosed with cancer and experienced healing not only physically but also in her heart. I began praying with my family, witnessing relationships I thought were beyond repair being transformed. We began to say "I love you "& "I am sorry" to each other in our household. For the first time in many years, I felt like I have a family.

During the six years of my Christian journey, encountering Jesus has changed me in ways I never thought possible. I have thought about it for a long time, and at this stage, there is nothing I want to do more than serving God.

Interestingly, when I mentioned the idea of attending seminary, Mrs. Kao informed me about a full-time female worker position needed at Taipei Christian Church. Through introductions and connections, they expressed their willingness to hire me and was willing to wait for my parents' approval. Though I had never given much thought to my future, it was the first time I had a blueprint in my heart.





In January 2023, before returning home in Malaysia for the Lunar New Year, I got sick because of COVID and had a high fever. In my most painful moment, a thought entered my mind, asking, "If you were to return to heaven now, would you like to?" I replied, "Well, I still want to see more people knowing God and being transformed. I want to witness what else God wants to do in this world." Afterward, I fell asleep, and the next day, my fever subsided. It was the first time I had consciously decided that I wanted to live.

My mother, being a Christian, initially didn't want me to go into full-time ministry, and my father, who is not a Christian, was skeptical when I discussed the idea of working at the church, thinking I was too obsessed. In this painful tension between wanting to honor God and my parents, I cried to God in prayer every day during my time in Malaysia. Many brothers and sisters called me specifically to pray with me. Thank God, the doors He opened could not be shut by anyone. After my mother prayed, she told me, "I knew a long time ago that you would walk this path. You are not only my daughter but also the inheritance entrusted by God." On my last day in Malaysia, after praying, I had another conversation with my father. It was the longest conversation I had ever had with him, lasting about 2-3 hours, and on that day, he finally agree to let me to work at the church.





The confirmation from God's Word, the leading of the Holy Spirit, the affirmation from the environment, the support of spiritual authority, and the peace God gave me—all seemed to be signs of confirmation.

I am grateful for every wonderful moment at 4C Church. Thank you, 4C Church, for introducing me to God. I have received so much love here, and I've learned the lesson of to love and being loved. I later realized that every time I stepped into other churches, I felt extremely nervous, but not at 4C Church. It truly feels like home to me, a place where I feel safe, accepted, and where I. truly belong.

Just like Abraham was called to leave his homeland, his relatives, and his father's house to go to the land God would show him. I believe this is the same for me. I want to confirm my calling, and even if I don't end up attending seminary or becoming a minister, I know it's okay. Because I know that as long as I am in the same boat as Jesus, he will guide me.

Before believing in Jesus, I used to feel anxious and pessimistic about things, but I would force myself to be strong and optimistic, which was really exhausting.

Li-fen was my college classmate, and we used to complain about everything together during our college days. After complaining, we would tease each other and encourage one another. We would spend our time complaining and being cynical toward this world

Several years later, we became mothers. Since our children were still young and couldn't go far, often our kids played together so we shared our experiences as mothers. Even though I became a mother a few years earlier than her, I was amazed at how Li-fen had such a good approach to parenting. She told me that she learned from the Bible. She hung the prayer of General MacArthur's prayer for his son on her door left a deep impression on me; it was then that I realized that besides the traditional ways of parenting, praying for our children could have such a great effect.



Those years were somewhat difficult for me, and I often received encouragements and help from Li-fen; I suddenly noticed the changes in her. She was no longer the person she used to be but became cheerful, optimistic, and bring warmth to others.

When my son became a teenager, I worried that he might make wrong friends. During that time, I remember the teachings from the Bible, so I decided to go to the 4C Church in the hope that my son could learn the right values. After attending the church, my son became more sensible and enjoyed his time there.

During my first visit to 4C Church, Li-fen asked me what I wanted to pray about to God. I felt embarrassed to say as it was my first time there, but she said that she will pray for me to quickly sell one of my house. At that time, I had another property for rent, but I didn't have extra time to manage it, and the mortgage was a big financial burden on me. I had been trying to sell it through real estate agents, but it didn't work out. I thought it would be tough to sell it during July of the Lunar calendar.



I handed the house over to the real estate agent the next day and 4 days later the agent told me the house was sold. I initially thought it might be a scam because it all happened so quickly. When I signed the contract, I finally believed it was true. I couldn't help but ask the buyer why she dared to buy a house during July of the Lunar calendar. The buyer and her daughter are both Christians, they didn't mind the superstitions. Originally, they were only looking for a place to rent but her daughter did not like the properties she looked at. However, when they saw my property, they like it a lot, and it was conveniently close to their church and their pastor was very delightful as well. So the buyer started sharing the gospel with me and the agent. I believe it was God's help and intervention! A few years ago, my son had a minor accident after school; my husband was in the mainland at that time, and I rushed to the hospital alone after receiving the news. Since it was rush hour, the traffic was heavy, so I chose to ride a motorcycle. Normally, I would be nervous and scared, and I might have had an accident on the

way, but God gave me peace in my heart, and I was not afraid at all. I had confidence in facing everything alone, knowing that God was with me.





At the police station, we watched the dashcam footage, and it showed that my son was hit by a sedan and thrown about 8 to 10 meters away. I was terrified and heartbroken, but I also thanked God for protecting him from any serious injuries. The following month was busy, and it rained almost every day, but everything went smoothly, from driving my son to school, seeing the doctor, or anywhere he needs to go. His wounds healed well! I am very thankful to God! I have been at the 4C Church for many years, and believing in Jesus has brought many changes to my life - in my mindset, finances, perspective on life, and many other aspects that have been lead my life getting better and better! Life inevitably has its storms and setbacks and when there are many things that are out of my control, I entrust them to God and believe that He has the best arrangements. Knowing God is the greatest blessing of my life!
