#### Baptismal Testimony - Annie Chen

I grew up in a Christian family, but never maintained the habit of attending church every Sunday. I would always find various excuses (such as studying or wanting to sleep) to skip church. Moreover, I would only turn to God when I was going through difficult or unhappy times. In high school, I experienced my first disagreement with a friend, leading to a strained and cold relationship. It was my first argument with a friend, and I dreaded going to school every day; I felt immense pressure at the thought of facing my friend. Although I considered talking to him to resolve the issue, but his temperament was tough, therefore I believed that talking would not improve the situation.

Later on, I returned to church for Sunday services. While singing hymns, tears streamed down my face uncontrollably. It wasn't because I was unhappy, but rather, I felt I was filled with the Holy Spirit. I experienced profound comfort, peace, and joy. As I left the church, I felt a significant lightening of my burdens. The week following that Sunday, miraculously, that classmate approached me to talk, and gradually, we restored our friendship. I realized that God had heard my prayers and was at work in our relationship.

On November 5th, during the first Sunday of November, I took communion with my parents. We read the scriptures shown at the bottom of the cup, and mine was Mark 12:30, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." While my parents found it deeply moving, I did not. I wondered if there was something I wasn't doing right or if I didn't love God enough. Two days later, Ita asked me about get baptized, and it suddenly dawned on me that this was Jesus speaking to me, guiding me on what to do.

After joining 4C Church, I gradually developed the habit of attending church every Sunday. I also learned to rely on God, looking up to Him for guidance. I am grateful that my parents never forced me to attend Sunday services or get baptized but allowed me to explore and decide on my own. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to choose to be baptized at 4C Church and for coming down from Taipei to support me. I am thrilled to be baptized in this beautiful and joyful month of December, and I hope to serve more and experience more of God in the future.

Lastly, I want to share a miracle that happened this week concerning my grandma. Since deciding to be baptized, I had been thinking about how to tell my grandma. I was afraid she would be upset or unwilling to come. However, since my grandma is one of the most important people in my life, I really wanted her to witness this important moment. Our conversation didn't start off smoothly, and I was so nervous that I didn't communicate the decision of getting baptized properly, and my grandma didn't agree to come. I began to pray to God, and He told me to let go of worries and regrets. Gradually, I stopped worrying, and I am thankful for God's work within me because my heart is now filled with peace! I am very grateful that my grandma is here witnessing my baptism today!

### Testimony – CHU, YOU-DIAN

When I was in first grade, my mother and I began to explore the Christian faith. I used to accompany my mother to church, but at that time, I couldn't grasp the concept of faith, so I resisted it.

It wasn't until I entered Chung Yuan Christian University that I had more opportunities to know more about Jesus. Starting from my sophomore year through the course in philosophy of humanity, I began to delve into this faith. This semester, I got to know 4C Church through Pastor Kao's class and met wonderful brothers and sisters who are very capable, warm, and loving. I participated in the Thanksgiving dinner preparation, witnessing everyone praying together and putting their hearts into creating a positive experience for those attending. After the event, the whole team cleaned up together, not leaving anyone behind. I was deeply moved by this scene, and I am honored to be part of this big family.

Before deciding to be baptized, my sense of fulfillment was based on the completion of my daily study progress. If I didn't meet the target for the day, I would fall into a cycle of staying up late to study, feeling mentally exhausted the next day, unable to get out of bed, being late, or even skipping classes. However, from the moment I decided to be baptized, many changes has happened within me. I started praying before sleep, asking the Lord to let me experience His power. When I wake up each day, I feel motivated, knowing that there are people accompanying me, supporting me, and I recognize it as the power of the Holy Spirit. It has freed me from the daily worries, no longer affected by the words or actions of other people, and granted me a clear mind, free from random thoughts.

During the period of leading up to my baptism, many bad habits were continually being eradicated, and I felt a sense of freshness in my life. I know this is the work of God within me, transforming me into a new person. Reading the Bible with Minister Skye has allowed me to approach things and face challenges from a perspective I had never seen before. This has relieved me from previous anxieties, giving me greater confidence in my future and choices. Because of Pastor Kao's class, I joined the Happiness Group, where I rediscovered leadership abilities previously overshadowed. After regaining this skill, I want to use it to serve God, allowing more people to know the King of Kings, experience Him, and have the opportunity to be reborn in Christ.
