Dear brothers and sisters, Shalom! May peace be upon you all.

I have a handy hairdryer, small yet powerful enough, which was a gift from my brother Zhenglin. He received it as a Christmas present in 2022.

" And indeed, it was me who was drew by Sister Shufen. Of course, there was applause and cheers

That year, the rule for Christmas gift exchanges was: the person who drew the gift had to pass it on to the next person. So, a funny incident occurred: Mark, Minister Skye, and Sister Shufen, the seminary students or graduate, ended up drawing gifts consecutively. This led to an uproar as everyone was joking and guessing who would be the next to attend seminary. A clear thought popped into my mind: "It's me! at that moment. This joke might have faded from memory, but it stirred up a year-long struggle within me: the question of "full-time ministry."

I struggled greatly during the discernment process. My name is Weihao, and I've been a Christian for ten years. At least, that's what I often say publicly. After graduation, as a disciple of the Lord entering into the real world, I worked diligently for His glory, aiming to be a good witness, fearing to bring shame to His name. "Love others as yourself" was my creed in the workplace, always ready to share the gospel and testimony with brothers, sisters, and colleagues.





But in 2022, my work was extremely painful. I pleaded to God, "Lead me out, I don't want to resign on my own." I hoped God would lead me out as He did with the Israelites in Exodus. God had mercy on me, compassionate my weakness at work. Amid misunderstandings with my department head and manager, I was unsure of what has happened, God led me out of the company in an Exodus-like manner. Thank God that I am wonderfully made. I finally realized I had begun to care for the lives of those around me.

God had already given me a vision for building young leaders. However, I feared that once I made the decision, all future career possibilities would be lost. I was afraid that God's answer would leave no room for my own thoughts, fearing being compelled by God. Thus, I dared not even think about "full-time ministry" for a long time.

At the end of 2023, I made a decision and boldly asked God: "Should I enter full-time ministry?" God responded, saying, "If you think spreading the gospel and shepherding are good things, then why not focus on doing them well?" God gave me this scripture: "Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation,

to doctrine." (I Timothy 4:13) I don't know how you all interpret this scripture, but let me tell you, I burst into tears.



In Psalm 139:7-10 says, "Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast."

I no longer worry about for the future, career planning, marriage, and other major life events, because after all, I have no control over them. Following the visions God gives me is the decision I made for this year. Who knows what scenery God has prepared for me?

Ecclesiastes 3:11 says, "He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end."

By faith, I took a step toward full-time ministry, and I decided to serve full time at 4C Church. Lastly, I want to encourage myself and my beloved brothers and sisters. Recently, I told my spiritual mentor about this decision, saying, "Hey, I'm entering full-time ministry." I was afraid he would scold me for not thinking it through. But he replied, "Who isn't?" Yes, brothers and sisters, we are all full-time children, soldiers, and servants of the kingdom of God. Thank you all.
