## 撒母耳記下 2 SAMUEL 14:1-33

14:1 洗魯雅的兒子約押，知道王心裏想念押沙龍，14:2 就打發人往提哥亞去，從那裏叫了一個聰明的婦人來，對她說：「請你假裝居喪的，穿上孝衣，不要用膏抹身，要裝作為死者許久悲哀的婦人；14:3 進去見王，對王如此如此說。」於是約押將當說的話教導了婦人。14:4 提哥亞婦人到王面前，伏地叩拜，說：

"As surely as the LORD lives," he said, "not one hair of your son's head will fall to the ground."

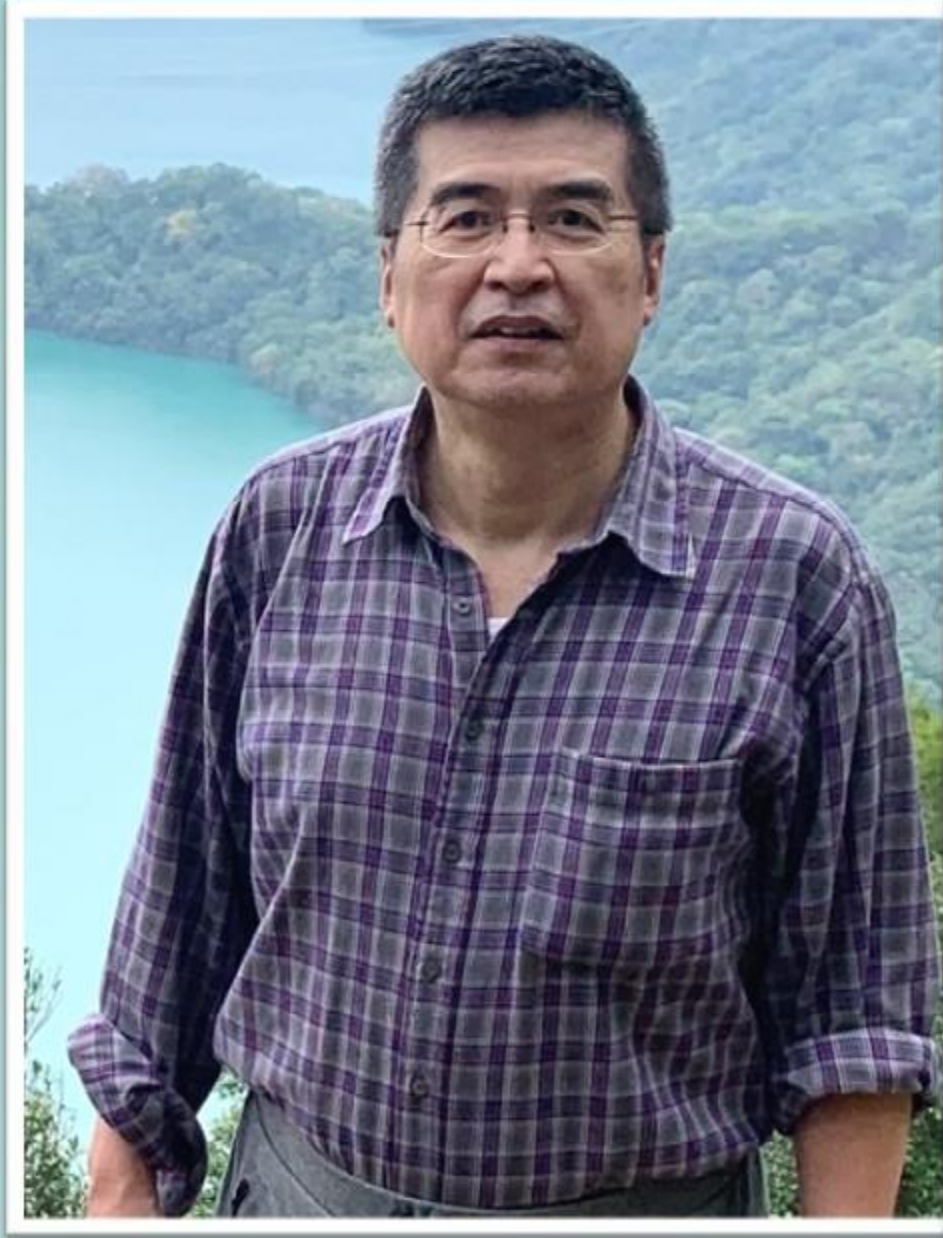

# Testimony – 呂崇夫 LU ChongFu

Good morning, everyone:

I am Lu Chongfu, an alumni of Chung Yuan University.

As many of you know, the United States is a country where Christianity is widely practiced. However, there is also a group of people there who don't believe in it. They believe in science and letting evidence speak for itself. This is why there is often a perceived conflict between faith and science.

# Testimony – 呂東晟 Dong Sheng

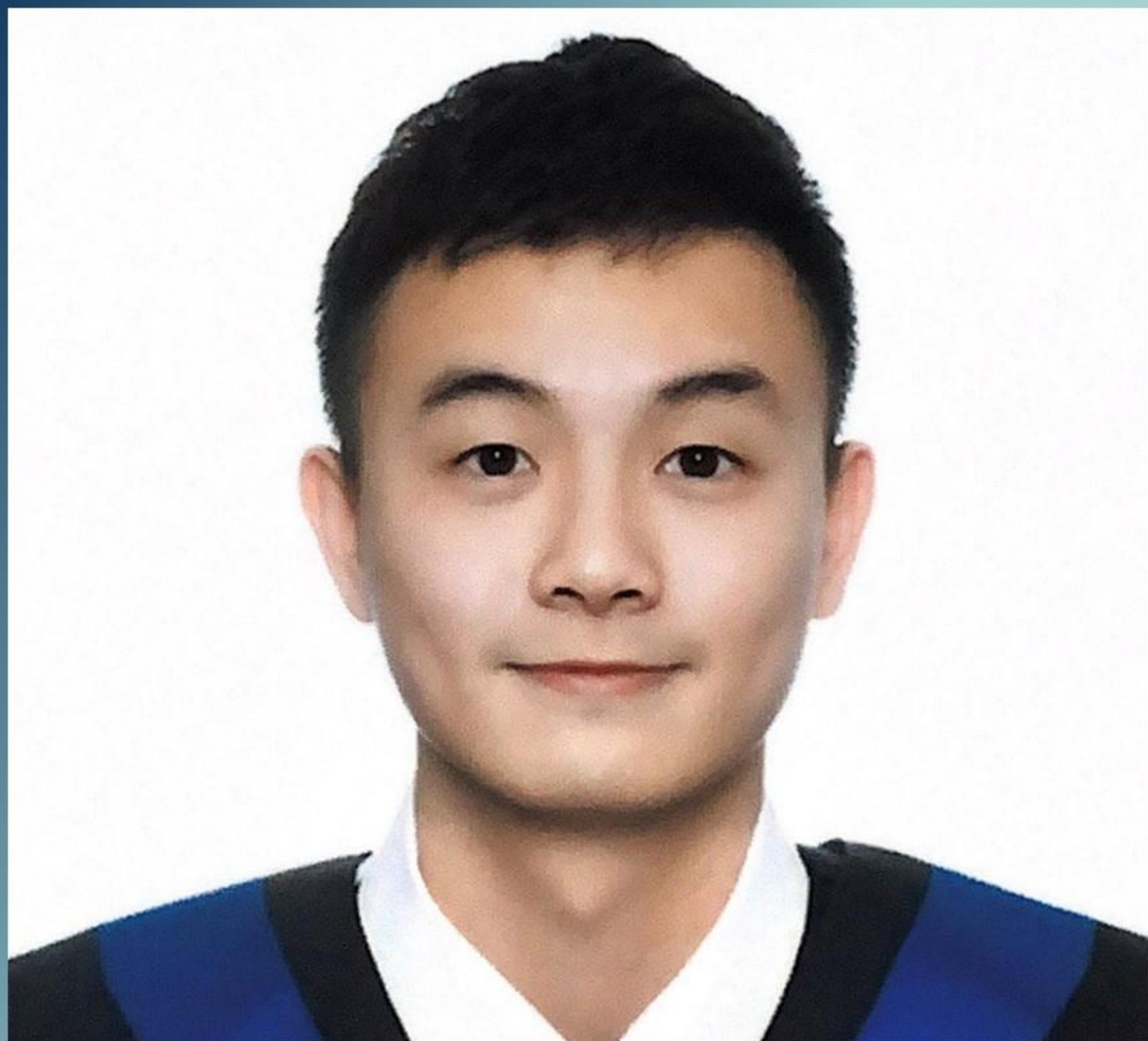

## Testimony – 高尉傑

My initial contact with the 4C Church started with attending a Gospel group. I was invited by a friend to attend the Thursday meetings with them. Originally, I only wanted to have a meal and chat with friends while meeting new people. I wasn't particularly curious about the faith and thought it would be like other church activities I had participated in before; I was not expecting it to affect my life in any way. However, the subsequent experiences completely overturned my expectations.

At first, I only attend the gathering occasionally like going to a class but after listening to several speakers' sharing I found their content was very rich and I also felt that they were very genuine. They admitted their shortcomings and weaknesses and shared their experiences with us. I was shocked because, from a young age, I had been taught to be honest and avoid lies. Yet, honest and upright people are often disliked, and revealing one's weaknesses can lead to backstabbing and ridicule. Because of this, I really appreciated their attitude, and it sparked my curiosity about this faith.

At that time, Minister Ai Tian and I weren't very familiar with each other, and she didn't know that I'm somewhat rebellious. I really dislike being pressured or told what to do, which is why my family never forced me to study. However, I didn't feel any pressure or discomfort at that moment, just a bit of confusion. I felt unlike myself; normally, I would think, "This person has an agenda, I'm annoyed, I'm leaving," but instead, I calmly replied, "Although my friends are getting baptized one after another, I want to experience it for myself before making a decision."

She suggested me that I could pray about it myself. I did what Minister Ai Tian suggested; I prayed to God however I had doubts about getting baptized and wasn't very willing. Yet, this God, even to someone still quite unfamiliar with Christianity, gave me a response I could accept.

I remember it was the last week of the Gospel group gathering in the semester, and everyone was sharing their most memorable experiences and thoughts of the meetings. The moment I heard the question, I had some thoughts in mind the most genuine thought in my heart.
