The first time I attended the Renewal Camp, my father had just passed away. However, due to my family's traditions, I had to consistently suppress my emotions at home, forcing myself not to cry.

- It wasn't until at the Renewal Camp that I felt the church's unconditional acceptance of my grief. It made me feel safe, allowing me to fully and freely mourn my father without holding back. For the first time, I felt that my emotions
- After the first Renewal Camp small group ended and I went home, I talked to God. At that time, I was still studying in the Physics Department, which brought me a lot of pain. My life was a mess, and I was deeply trapped in grief. limitations and deeply realized that only God could transform my chaotic life and heal my shattered heart. After that

During the second Renewal Camp, I gained more spiritual knowledge and understanding. I also realized that I had never truly faced or forgiven myself for not handling my father's passing well. I kept wondering, could I have done better? Would things have turned out differently if I had chosen another way?

The night of the Holy Spirit session in the camp, I started to forgive the Lin Pei-Yu of that time. I forgave every decision and action the Lin Pei-Yu made, recognizing that she was overwhelmed and unsured of what to do. I also came to understand that I had done my best, because it was my first time facing such situation. I also realized that I needed to learn how to receive love, rather than constantly blaming or condemning myself. This include accepting the care of those around me and embracing the unconditional love of my Heavenly Father.

This year's Renewal Camp what felt most different was that, in addition to attending pre-camp prayer meetings, I also fasted and refrained from entertainment. Through these preparations, I realized that I am not just someone who receives help—I am also someone who gives blessings and meant to be used by God. I was reminded not to let anyone look down on me because of my youth.

One of the most significant moments for me during this year's camp was on the second day when we recited the prayer declarations together. As I spoke the words, I felt extreme discomfort, as if nails were embedded in my head. It was incredibly painful, and I had the urge to bang my head against the table. I realized this discomfort stemmed from my family's past involvement in idol worship.





Therefore, at lunch break, I sought prayer from my small group leader. During the prayer, I discovered a spirit that I had mistaken as my dad. But it wasn't actually him. Still, I refused to let it go because I was afraid—afraid that by releasing it, I would be letting go of my father once again, abandoning him. I missed him so much that I desperately clung to the spirit, unwilling to let it go.

When prayed for the deliverance, I was terrified. What if it really was my dad? I was also afraid it would harm me. cried uncontrollably, shaking with fear, and my heart ached deeply. I was troubled that I would stop missing my father, worried that I might forget him completely and become heartless. The false spirit, pretending to be my father, continuously used various accusations and fears to torment me.

In the afternoon, when we prayed for breaking the ancestral curses, my headache returned—this time so intense that I had to rest my head on the cold surface of the table, trying to cool down my burning and painful head. The discomfort was so overwhelming, and I could barely continue reciting the prayers. Then, one of my group members shared with me and reminded me that we all have our own spiritual battles and that it's okay to cry. And I shouldn't feel like something was wrong with me.

Later, I went to seek prayer from Pastor Kao. As he prayed for me, I felt the sense of protection under spiritual authority. I also realized that I hadn't truly believed in God's power—that I hadn't fully trusted that He is strong enough to cast out evil spirits. After the prayer, I felt completely freed.

For example, when worshiping, I became more willing to being filled by the Holy Spirit and allowing God to use me. I was no longer afraid to sing out loudly in praise. I also learned how to discern between God's voice and the enemy's attacks when confronted with accusations or intrusive thoughts. The experience helped me develop a deeper sensitivity to spiritual matters.

am incredibly grateful to God for using this year's Renewal Camp to teach me how to recognize thoughts that are not from Him. I have also gained many prayers written based of Bible which will help me stand firm in spiritual battles whenever needed. Through the Renew Camp, I have become more willing to step forward for God. Even when my legs tremble, I am still willing to take those steps and move forward.
